URGENT: Oppose plans to introduce Assisted Suicide to Scotland

Care Not Killing (CNK), supported by the Catholic Parliamentary Office, has launched a petition which aims to stop plans to legalise assisted suicide.

Liam McArthur MSP, has indicated that he expects to introduce his assisted suicide bill at Holyrood in early 2023, so we must act quickly.

This bill risks undermining the provision of palliative care and undermining efforts to prevent suicide. It will make the most vulnerable people, including the elderly and disabled, feel like a burden and its safeguards will prove futile. The current law is the safeguard - it prohibits assisting someone's suicide and/or killing them by euthanasia. The state ought to support the provision of care, not deliberate killing, for those at the end of life.

Care2Knit

Anna the lady from BJDS who has been looking for knitters has kindly provided more information. The blankets are for the Wayside Club and Men Matters, a mental health organisation. They are looking for people who can knit but also people who may be able to donate a blanket and a hot water bottle. Anna informs us that she has managed to get 70 knitters involved but also says that they are looking for hats and scarfs for both adults and children. They are also looking for knitting needles 6,5 Or 7mm and wool. They are hoping to set up a knitting group soon. The pattern for wool blankets is, if using double knit use 2 balls of wool together, cast on 90 stitches, knit 200 to 220 rows depending on tight or loose knitter. She has also asked each person who knits a blanket to put a wee note in saying that it was made for the person and hand knitted with love.
