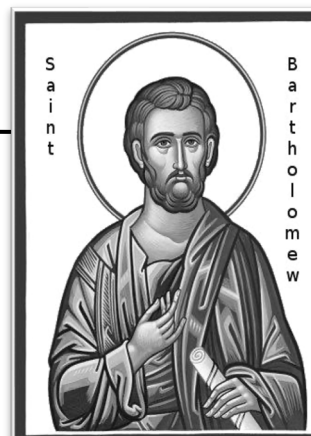

ST. BARTHOLOMEW'S SACRAMENT PROGRAMME 2026

Details of all dates for Enrolment for Sacraments, Sacrament dates and Sacramental Preparation Classes can be found on the notice board in the church entrance and on the parish website.

For Reconciliation, First Holy Communion and Confirmation, the children who will be receiving these sacraments (along with their parents/guardian) **must** attend an Enrolment Mass **prior** to beginning the relevant Sacramental Preparation classes within the parish.

Enrolment Masses are scheduled as follows:

RECONCILIATION	(P3 children)	Sunday 1 st February 2026, 11:30am
CONFIRMATION	(P7 children)	Sunday 8 th February 2026, 11:30am
FIRST COMMUNION	(P4 children)	Sunday 19 th April 2026, 11:30am

PLEASE NOTE : Your child **CANNOT** receive any other sacrament until they have been Baptised

ST. BARTHOLOMEW'S CHILDREN'S LITURGY

As the children prepare for Reconciliation, First Holy Communion or Confirmation over the next few months, you may wish to attend our 11:30am Sunday Mass to enable your child to attend our Children's Liturgy.

Our Children's Liturgy helps our children to reflect on and understand the Word of God at their own level.

Our Children's Liturgy catechists all have a PVG membership specifically for their roles, which allows them to work with the children.

Any other adults should **NOT** attend Children's Liturgy. For Sacramental Preparation, only those catechists who have a current PVG for this role can attend the preparation classes.

Children aged 4 and primary school children are welcome to attend.
