### MONTHLY PRO-LIFE MASS

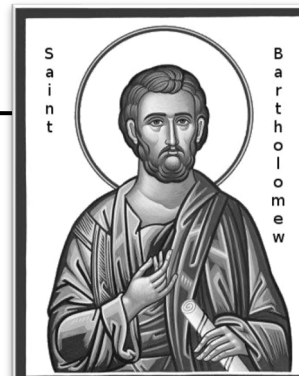
