Father Thomas O'Brien

Mill Hill Missionary



21st May 1948 - 7th May 2022

Fr. Tom O'Brien was a former parishioner of St. Bartholomew's parish and when he was ordained in St. Bartholomew's in 1974 by the (then) Archbishop, Thomas Winning, it was a very special occasion for the parish. I'm sure some of you will recall his ordination day and hold special memories of the event.

After his ordination, and further studies in Rome, Fr. Tom initially served in various locations in India, followed by a spell in Saint Joseph's House, Cardonald, then London and in 2009, he moved to Liverpool where he continued working until he died last week.

Anytime Fr. Tom was home to see his Mum, Molly, he always visited the parish and gave his time so freely by assisting with Masses and services. He last visited the parish on 24th August 2015, when he celebrated Mass with us for our Diamond Jubilee and Pastoral Feast.

Fr. Tom had been ill for a number of months, and sadly lost his fight for life last weekend. Please remember Fr. Tom, his sister Mary Jo, brother Paul and their families, and all in the Mill Hill Community in your prayers.

Fr. Tom's funeral will take place on Tuesday 17th of May at Herbert House, Formby, Liverpool. His remains will be interred in the Mill Hill Missionary cemetery next to Herbert House.
