



WORLD DAY FOR GRANDPARENTS and the ELDERLY

Elderly people symbolise the transmission of faith from age to age

Sunday 23 July, marks the 3rd World Day for Grandparents and the Elderly. The theme chosen for this year is "His mercy is from age to age," recalling a passage from Luke's Gospel.

Holy Mass that will be presided over by Pope Francis at 10 a.m. local time inside St. Peter's Basilica, and it will see the participation of over 6,000 people, including "many elderly people from all over Italy."

At the end of the celebration, five elderly people - one representative from each continent - "will symbolically hand over the World Youth Day Pilgrim's Cross to five young people leaving for Lisbon."

The gesture symbolises the "transmission of faith from age to age" but also "the commitment that the elderly and grandparents have accepted, at the invitation of the Holy Father, to pray for the departing youth and accompany them with their blessing."

All those who will attend the event at St. Peter's will receive a specific prayer to offer for the Day, along with a copy of the Pope's message to grandparents and the elderly.

May God bless our Grandparents and the Elderly.

The Ecclesiastical BDiv is a five-year part-time, collaborative-learning degree programme in Catholic theology providing a comprehensive exposition and analysis of Christian doctrine based on the study of the sacred Scriptures, the works of the Fathers and Doctors of the Church, and the documents of the Magisterium.

WORLD YOUTH DAY 2023

Domingos Fezas Vital, the Portuguese Ambassador to the Holy See, speaks about the "deep sense of responsibility," but also of the "immense joy" that is accompanying the entire country toward World Youth Day 2023. The ambassador's hope is for the upcoming World Youth Day "to be seen as a sign of hope in a better world, more just and more sustainable."

The event will take place in Lisbon, from 1 to 6 August, and will see the presence of over 400,000 young people from all over the world.

The motto chosen by Pope Francis for this year's World Youth Day is: "Mary arose and went with haste," recalling Luke's Gospel account of the Visitation.

Among the various moments characterising the Pope's participation in World Youth Day, there is a moment of prayer for peace that Pope Francis will have in Fatima.
