### CLOCKS CHANGE NEXT WEEKEND!

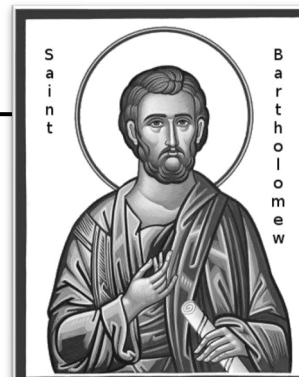
Don’t forget to put your clocks FORWARD 1 hour next Saturday night (officially, British Summertime begins at 1am on Sunday morning).

**EASTER TRIDUUM**

The summit of the Liturgical Year is the Easter Triduum – from the evening of Holy Thursday through to Easter Vigil on Saturday night. The single celebration of the Triduum marks the end of the Lenten season and leads to the Mass of the Resurrection of the Lord at the Easter Vigil. Our services in St. Bartholomew's for the Easter Triduum of the Passion of the Lord and Easter Sunday are as follows:

<b>HOLY THURSDAY</b> Mass of the Lord's Supper Followed by gathering at Altar of Repose for personal prayer.	7pm  Until 9pm
<b>GOOD FRIDAY</b> The Lord's Passion Church will remain open after the 3pm service for personal visit and veneration of the cross.	3pm  Until 8pm
<b>HOLY SATURDAY</b> Easter Vigil	7:30pm
<b>EASTER SUNDAY</b>	11am
